Subject:- Admission to NEET UG, 2017.

Notification No. 087-BOPEE of 2017 Dated 06-08-2017

Whereas, vide Notification No. 083-BOPEE of 2017 dated 03-08-2017 provisional list of the candidates admitted to medical/dental courses in the State Colleges was notified; and

Whereas, candidates were given time up to 05-08-2017 6.00 p.m. to make representations, if they choose to-do so to the position assigned to them/non inclusion in the list; and

Whereas, as consequence of the above, four representations were received with following:-

1. Mr. Adil Ahmad, NEET Roll No. 903307012 (NEET Score 405) stating that the sports ranking and not the NEET merit should be considered for selection/filing up of the seats under sports quota;
2. Ms. Bi-Bi Inabat, NEET Roll No. 903312305 and Bhavya Singh Chib NEET Rank 37566, State Rank 220 regarding Rule 17 of the Reservation Rules and resultant seats in the Open Merit/reserve category;
3. Mr. Farooq Ahmad Shah, NEET Roll No. 903307246, NEET Rank 34106, State Rank 193. Non inclusion in the admission list with higher score/rank/non consideration under P&B category;
4. Ms. Anchal Dogra, NEET Roll No. 80885102, NEET Rank 100175, State Rank 1085 has represented against some candidates, who according to her had not applied under sports category before the Board should not have been considered under sports category; and
5. Mr. Aabid Hussain Bhat, NEET Roll No. 903306197, State Rank 243, Category JKPM, stating that the seat matrix in respect of JKPM has not been reflected properly.

Whereas, these representations ad seriatim have been examined and considered by the Board and it has been observed as under:-

1. Sports rank is only for purposes of short listing the candidates and cannot be considered for allotment of seats/disciplines/colleges, which has to be purely on the basis of NEET score. This has been held by the Hon'ble High Court Division Bench in the case titled Karnav Mahajan in OWP No.537/2015 vide its order dated 07-11-2016 in somewhat similar case related to the PG course. Provision in the MCI Regulations for admission in the UG courses also prescribes the selection of candidate on the basis of merit obtained in the examination which in no case can be compromised.
