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## Important Instructions for CET-II (2016) Candidates

Notification No. 57-BOPEE of 2016

Dated: 21-07-2016

All the candidates of CET-II (2016) are hereby informed to take note of the following instructions:-

- (i) The CET-II will be held on 31<sup>st</sup> (Sunday) July, 2016 at the designated Test Centres of Jammu and Srinagar with two meetings (Morning and Afternoon Sessions).
- (ii) Only Electronic Admit Cards are available for CET-II (2016).
- (iii) Candidates should download the same from 22nd of July, 2016 from the official websites of BOPEE viz. <http://www.jakbopee.org> / <http://www.jakbopee.net> (through URL's Provided for this purpose). **The candidates of Kashmir Division can also approach district NIC Centres located in office premises of Deputy Commissioner of all the districts for downloading of their Admit Cards. Similar services are available in Community Information Centres also.**
- (iv) The Paper-A (Physics and Chemistry) will have 120 questions to be attempted in 120 minutes.
- (v) The Paper-B (Biology) will have 60 questions to be attempted in 60 minutes.
- (vi) The reporting time for morning session is 10:00 A.M. and for afternoon session is 01:25 P.M.
- (vii) **The candidates must necessarily bring their Admit Card at the Test Centre along with Valid additional Photo Identity Proof which includes Identity Card of the school, Adhar Card, PAN Card , Election Card, Driving License, Passport etc**

#### Paper-'A' [PHYSICS AND CHEMISTRY]

10:00 A.M.	Reporting time in the Examination Hall
10:05 A.M.	The Invigilator shall ascertain the identity of each candidate by comparing his/her facial appearance with the photographs given on the admit card, and attendance sheet. The centre Superintendent shall also check the identity of the candidates and ensure that only the genuine candidates have been allowed to sit in the Examination Hall and there is no case of impersonation.
10:15 A.M.	Candidates will be given OMR Answer Sheets. They will go through Instructions on the Answer Sheet.
10:25 A.M.	They will be given Question Booklet. The Question Booklet number is to be entered on the Answer Sheet.
10.30 A.M.	They will break open the seal of the Question Booklet and start attempting the questions.
12.30 P.M.	Paper- A ends The candidates will remain in their seats till they hand over the Answer Sheets to the Invigilator and leave the Examination Hall only when they are asked to do so.

#### Paper-'B' [BIOLOGY]

Afternoon Session	Work Schedule
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01 :25 P.M	Reporting time in the Examination Hall
01:30 P.M.	The Invigilator shall ascertain the identity of each candidate by comparing his/her facial appearance with the photographs given on the admit card and attendance sheet. The centre Superintendent shall also check the identity of the candidates and ensure that only the genuine candidates have been allowed to sit in the Examination Hall and there is no case of impersonation.
01:45 P.M.	Candidates will be given OMR Answer Sheets. They will go through instructions on the Answer Sheet.
01:55 P.M.	They will be given Question Booklet. The Question Booklet number is to be entered on the Answer Sheet.
02:00 P.M.	They will break open the seal of the Question Booklet and start attempting the questions.
03:00 P.M.	Paper-B ends The candidates will remain in their seats till they hand over the Answer Sheets to the Invigilator and leave the Examination Hall only when they are asked to do so.

- (viii) The candidates who have committed mistake(s) while uploading any information/image on the online Application Form must report to the BOPEE office Jammu/ Srinagar for correction well before the date of Entrance Test.
- (ix) The candidates must check the Question Booklet thoroughly before attempting to answer any question. Where a Question Booklet has any missing page, blank page, missed question or damaged or defaced page, it shall be the responsibility of the concerned candidate to bring it into the notice of the concerned Invigilator/ Superintendent or any other supervisory staff and get it replaced by a new Booklet of the same series. The Question Booklet must have 120 questions in Paper 'A' and 60 questions in Paper 'B'. No complaint in this regard shall be entertained by the Board after the conclusion of the Entrance Test.
- (x) The candidates must make it absolutely sure that the entries made on the OMR Answer and Attendance Sheets are correct. Where a candidate has made any wrong entry of Roll No., Booklet No., or Booklet Series, he/she should report it to the Invigilator / Superintendent or **report it within three days** after the conclusion of the Entrance Test **to the BOPEE office**, Jammu/Srinagar positively, failing which no complaint shall be entertained and the OMR Answer Sheet shall be evaluated strictly as per the entries made by the candidate.
- (xi) The candidates should not bring any electronic gadget in the Test Centre.
- (xii) The candidates should **darken only one response** on the OMR Sheet. There is a negative marking of 0.25 for each wrong answer. Avoid double shading of Ovals or putting of stray or faint marks on the Oval in the OMR sheet. Even shading of one Oval completely and another Oval partly / faintly is considered a case of double shading which will make response wrong even if fully shaded Oval is the correct option.
- (xiii) The BOPEE shall make the answer key available on its website in the evening on the conclusion of last meeting of the examination for candidates to make representation, if any. The candidates can make representation, if any, against any question in the question paper on the prescribed format accompanied by a fee of rupees 500 (five hundred) per paper within a period of three working days upto 04:00 P.M. after the conclusion of the Entrance Test. The representations should be supported by the documentary proof, based on standard text books. The material downloaded from the Internet will not be accepted as it is uploaded without any editorial review. The revised key, if required, will be uploaded on the website for general information but no



representation will be entertained against revised key. The revised key will be applied for evaluation of all the Answer Sheets including Answer Sheets of those candidates who have not made any representation.

- (xiv) There is no provision for re-evaluation. However, re-totalling of marks will be allowed on written request by depositing rupees 1000 at POS at BOPEE office, Jammu/Srinagar. The application will be received within 03 (three) days after the declaration of result. Any application received after this date shall not be entertained.
